



Restoration Carpenter job description

Job Summary:

To perform necessary tasks to profitably complete projects for Commercial, Residential, & Institutional facilities' Emergency Services, Mitigation and Reconstruction. These tasks include anything necessary for the completion of the projects ranging in complexity from construction demolition, light trade work to complex finish carpentry.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AS A RESTORATION CARPENTER:

Core duties and responsibilities include the following as well as other duties that may be assigned.

- Successful track record as a Multi-Skilled Tradesman
- Primary responsibility of successful completion of complex carpentry tasks and general construction work.
- Perform tasks related to carpentry, drywall, paint, finish trim, cabinet installation, and minor electrical and plumbing.

Erects framework for structures and build-out projects

Performs various types of flooring projects

Covers sub-floor with building paper to keep out moisture.

Applies shock-absorbing, sound-deadening drywall to ceilings and walls.

Constructs forms and chutes for pouring concrete and demolition work as well as constructing temporary supports & bracing to structures.

Erects scaffolding and ladders for assembling structures above ground level according to and within safety requirements.

Performs all projects to meet local and national building codes.

Performs basic electrical and plumbing work projects.

Performs basic sealing and painting for exterior and interior projects.

Performs drywall hanging and finishing projects

Fire /Storm damage restoration, Water mitigation/Drying procedures and Smoke/Mold remediation skills will be taught

Participates in rotating EMERGENCY SERVICE on-call schedule.

Performs board-up & mitigation work on emergency service calls.

Performs general demolition work.

Performs basic structural and contents cleaning after fire or other disaster situations.

Assists in pack-outs and pack-ins of inventories as directed.

Maintains and abides by all company safety and OSHA regulations.

Maintains a clean and safe work environment at all times.

Maintains effective communication and documentation with all parties involved with a project

QUALIFICATIONS:

High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or one to three years. related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

2-3 Years experience in carpentry, disaster restoration and/or general handyman

Must be able to pass a criminal background check

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence.

Ability to calculate figures and amounts such as interest, percentages, area, circumference, and volume as well as the ability to read a tape measure. Ability to apply commonsense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form. Ability to deal with problems.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand; walk; sit; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; and talk or hear.

The employee must regularly lift and/or move more than 75 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

The noise level in the work environment is sometimes loud.
